Vehicle Purchase

1. Purpose

Franklin County Public Hospital District #1 (FCPHD#1) is seeking to procure one (1) new Sport Utility Vehicle (SUV) for official government use. The vehicle will be utilized by administrative staff, command personnel, emergency response support operations, and district business. The selected vehicle must provide reliable year-round transportation, including operation during adverse weather conditions and on unimproved roadways within the district's service area.

2. Specifications

a. Minimum Vehicle Requirements

- New, Current model year vehicle
- Full-size OR Mid-size SUV
- Four-wheel drive (4x4) system
- Seating capacity minimum of five (5) occupants
- Automatic transmission
- Gasoline or Diesel engine
- Minimum towing capacity of 5,000 pounds
- Ground-clearance suitable for rural and off-pavement travel

b. Safety Equipment Requirement

- Front, side, and curtain airbags
- Anti-lock braking system (ABS)
- Electronic Stability control
- Traction control
- Backup camera
- Blind spot monitoring system
- Rear cross-traffic alert
- Adaptive cruise control
- Lane departure warning
- Automatic emergency braking

c. Interior Requirements

- Air conditioning and heating
- Leather or leather-like seating
- Power windows and door locks
- Remote Keyless entry
- Heavy-duty all-weather floor mats
- Adjustable driver's seat
- Multiple USB charging ports
- Bluetooth connectivity

d. Exterior Requirements

- White Exterior Paint preferred
- Running Boards
- Trailer Hitch Receiver
- Full-size spare tire

3. Vendor Proposal Requirements / Submittal

Vendors must provide the following information as part of the proposal:

1. Vehicle make and model
2. Vehicle specifications demonstrating compliance with requirements
3. Warranty information
4. Estimated delivery date
5. Total purchase price, including all fees and taxes. This includes any available government, state, or cooperative purchase pricing.

Deadline for submission of proposals: Noon, July 9, 2026; No bid will be considered which has not been received by the deadline set forth.
